What have the Otters been up to this week?

- This week in Maths we have looked different ways of multiplying 2 or 3 digit numbers by a 1 digit number. We have used partitioning as well as column multiplication with and without exchanging.
- In English, we have written in role as the old man as well as explored the settings in the story and poetry. The children really enjoyed the poem 'Gran can you rap?' and I read/rapped it to them 4 times!!! As they tapped the beat. We have also done lots of work on adverbs this week as this links to this week's spellings.
- This week for Geography, we have described life in the rainforest and for Art we have begun to design our own rainforest scenes, looking at the colours we use and how that may reflect the mood of a piece.
- In Science, we drew plants and labelled them with their different parts and the functions. we used what we learnt at the start of the year at the farm to help us understand how seeds are dispersed and listed the different ways plants can grow.
- For Welly Wednesday this week, the children looked for 'Y' shaped sticks to help them build dens. They made some impressive creations.
