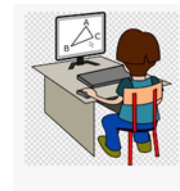

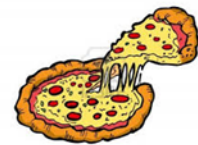
Monday
