Six wives timeline: Create an illustrated timeline of Henry VIII's six wives, including what happened to each one.

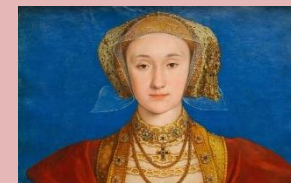


An idea of your own!

Can you write a special prayer that we could use in worship? I would also like us to create a Badgers Class Prayer book and these prayers could go in there.



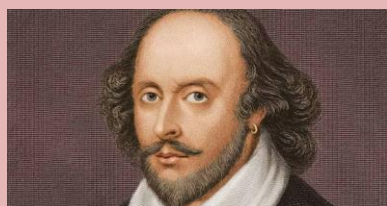
DT:
