I am so impressed with how the children have adapted to using the environment purposefully and collaboratively. They are also building up their stamina for short adult led inputs throughout the day.

In singing worship we have begun to practise songs for Harvest, so if you hear "Big Red Combine Harvester" you know why!

During phonics the children have worked really hard. They have been introduced to the sounds g/o/c/k. They are getting really confident to segment and blend CVC words. Our tricky word this week was 'is'. I have sent the sounds home this week so you can see what we will cover up to the October break.

This week we have worked hard in maths to automatically recall number bonds to 5. This is a tricky concept so we will continue this next week.

It was great to use a Chatty Mat in RE and hear what the children saw and wondered about a beautiful pictorial interpretation of the Creation Story.

In Expressive Art and Design we explored colour mixing with primary colours.
