Minutes of Meeting 17th May 2023 9am to 10.30am

In attendance: Emma Biswal (Treasurer) Lucy Everett (Chair) Julie Simmons (Head Teacher) Ellie Shepard, Farah (Governor) Ellie-Louise Clarke (Social Media Manager), Trina (Trustee), Carrie (Trustee), Marc (Trustee), Mrs Baker (Teacher)

Absent: Phil and Kaz

The rebranding of the old Friends Charity to The Stelling Minnis School PTA was discussed. Ideas were discussed about how we could best communicate the new committee to the wider school and community effectively.

We are not able to cancel Parentkind.

ACTION LUCY: Lucy to change new name on bank account.

ACTION ELLIE: Ellie-Louise Clarke will be taking over as admin on the facebook page and will change name on the facebook page.

ACTION LUCY: We have successfully had all funds moved to the new Virgin bank account. Lucy to tell Jill to shut down old the old accounts and provide proof of closure.

ACTION LUCY: Lucy to produce a mailer informing parents of the committee changes such as new PTA, governor and school involvement. Lucy to write a notice to school informing them of new bank details. To be distributed by school to bookbags, on dojo and all methods possible.

In order to help wider school community to identify committee members it was agreed we would distribute information about the committee members including photographs and some details about each committee member.

ACTION TRINA: Trina to produce new logo artwork for the rebrand and to take photos of the new committee. ACTION LUCY & EMMA: Lanyards to be purchased either by school or committee with ID tags so Committee members can be identified by wider school community. Mrs Baker requested these be RED to be consistent with lanyard colours already being used.

Ellie Shepard informed the committee that she began writing new policies such as cash handling polices. Ellie Shepard was voted in as new Committee Secretary. Ellie has accepted.

Trina has officially joined as a committee member of the group.

ACTION EMMA AND TRINA: Emma and Trina to speak to Emily and Annabel on Friday about joining the committee.

ACTION EMMA: It was agreed that we should look into setting up new virgin account with either quickbooks or xero and stop using freeagent. It was agreed this would be money well spent. Quickbooks appears to be cheaper option. Emma to take a back up of current books from freeagent so that year end accounts can be done. Download Trial balance.

ACTION LUCY, EMMA & ELLIE-LOUSE CLARK: It was agreed that parents should be notified to stop paying money into 100 Club account. This will become the Stelling Minnis Small School Lottery and will be a yearly subscription. Emma and Lucy to issue Refunds for any advance payments. It was agreed that this would go online and be autogenerated and published on facebook by video by new social media manager Ellie-Louise Clark. The prize fund would also be reviewed inline with participation. It was noted that money is owed for the April draw. All further funds will be refunded. Bank transfer was agreed as the method for payment. It was agreed the charity should be cashless wherever possible.

ACTION EMMA: Bookkeeping going forward to be "cloud based" with all original documents available online for all users. At least two other users should be identified so to allow full transparency of funds.

ACTION FARAH: Farah to set up a line of communication on dojo for parents to get direct access to a committee member.

There is a temporary hold on committee events until rebranding is underway including matchbox.

Bootfair has been cancelled due to rebranding efforts. Refund owed to stall holders paid.

ACTION EMMA: Fathers Day Breakfast agreed to be taken over by the school (other events to be discussed in the next meeting) Emma to ask Emily if she can help school with food for breakfast.

ACTION MRS SIMMONS: The combining of the sports day currently organised for the 26th May and the summer fair were discussed. Mrs Simmonds to confirm a date for sports day after confirming Kate's availability. Potentially Friday 30th May

ACTION ALL: Active efforts to be made to rebuild relationships with the preschool, the preschool parents and PTA. Possible joint collaboration of the sports day event to be considered. Joint collaboration and building of bridges agreed to be key to the building of the schools reputation and intake.

ACTION LUCY: Lucy to issue a notice cancelling the hoodies purchase for year 6 to go out with this weeks attendance letters. To be issued to all year 6 parents. Refunds to be issued as and when they are identified. **ACTION EMMA:** Poster of new committee PTA to be put up in local shop.

It was agreed by all that Emma and Lucy will remain in current positions on the new committee.

ACTION FARAH & TRINA: New PTA logo to go onto Dojo

Mrs Baker suggested that compared to other schools, the charity does not ask enough of its parents in terms of financial support. Next meeting to focus on the fundraising targets for the year ahead, the events planned for the year, what events will be returned to the school. Lucy to confirm possible dates.
