Impact for 2022/2023

- 100% of pupils benefitted from Specialist PE provision with 20% being selected to represent the school at an
 annual District Sports Competition against other schools in the district. Stelling Minnis came first place in the
 small schools category creating a sense of pride for the school community and achievement for the
 competition pupils. 100% of pupils benefited from specialist equipment being used to ensure breadth of
 offer for Physical education.
- 100% of pupils took part in a Mission Possible Day providing the children with practical and physical problem-solving challenges. This opportunity allowed the children to better understand that physical exercise can take place in many forms. They were exercising without realising it.
- 100% of children benefited from a dance workshop from a specialist dancer which linked to their musical preferences allowing further breadth to their physical learning experiences
- 100% of year 6 and 88% of year 5 were able to access Hindleap Residential centre exploring specialist activities not available at school such as zip lining, leap of faith, orienteering, rock climbing by specialist instructors. Supporting their transition to secondary school as character building and resilience.
- 100% of KS2 attended a Kent Cricket Match. Seeing "real" cricket was a great experience for the children to see professional players compete at a professional level. The children were inspired to meet some of the players.
- 100% of children took part in our own community event- the Minnis Run which allows the children to enjoy taking part in sport as part of a fun run creating a sense of belonging and ownership of an event in the community.
