Dear Parents/Carers

We have had some visitors to school this week. Our Chair of Governors, Pam Burgess, has checked our safeguarding procedures as part of her Governor monitoring work and is happy that all is in order. Two School Improvement Advisors (SIA) have also visited and are very pleased with our progress through the School Improvement Plan.

As part of the SIA's visit, we have been asked to start using a Late book which is referred to in our attendance policy. In future, if a child arrives at school after the main gate is shut, the parent must bring them to the office and sign the Late book. I realise this is an inconvenience, but Kent require us to do this and it forms part of our safeguarding and attendance procedures.

In worship today, I discussed a number of points with the children. We reminded ourselves that this is a Healthy School and that suitable snacks at break time are fruit, vegetables or cereal bars only. We agreed that toys should not be brought to school unless this had been previously agreed with the class teacher. We also considered how smart children look when they wear school uniform tidily and tie back their long hair.

Next week is Book Week. There will be several activities in and between classes. On Friday, the children are asked to come to school wearing pyjamas as we will be looking at bedtime stories. The usual Book Fair will visit next month.

On Tuesday 28th February, Mrs Nicholls is holding a Phonics Workshop for Year 1 parents, to explain the Phonics Screening Test. This will start at 2.30pm. Please enter through the Hall Door and you can sign in there.

Finally, one or two parents have been dropping the children at the gate before 8.45am and leaving. This could result in an accident if the child strays into the car park or road or trips over when unsupervised.
