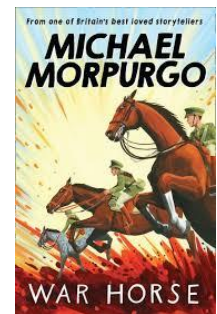


Our new school values are: **Curiosity, Courage and Compassion.**

What have the Badgers been up to this week?

- This week in Badgers we have explored each of our new values. For curiosity we worked in small groups and pairs to ask each other questions and to try to find out more about each other.
- For Courage, on Thursday we looked at Edith Cavell ; an inspirational woman who showed great courage during the First World War as a nurse and helping soldiers escape from Germany.
- Today for compassion we thought about how acts of kindness are compassionate and show people that we care. The Badgers created affirmations on love hearts. We decorated them and laminated them and handed them out to everyone at school.
- In Maths we have started a little arithmetic - focusing on addition and subtraction. We have also started our work on place value. Well done Badgers!
- The Badgers have done some writing this week - writing about a day from their summer break.
- This term we are reading Warhorse - we have made predictions about what will happen in the story and we have read aloud chapter 1.
