This week we have managed three reading sessions working on retrieval and skills for different question types. Our RE unit this term is Humanism. In Spanish we have been learning classroom words and the Badgers created labels for the classroom. In Science we are learning about the circulatory system and the human heart. Hopefully we can complete an experiment next week!
