Welcome back to school Otters and what a busy first two days we have had!

- We have been getting to know each other and exploring our new classroom. We have focussed on our routines and expectations in class and around the school. These have been through games like 'Following the leader' and 'Musical chairs.'
- In Maths we have started our work on place value, using place value counters to make three-digit numbers and identify them. Making given three-digit numbers and identifying how many hundreds, tens and ones represent each digit.
- Everyone completed a Times Table baseline assessment. I will be sending home their scores and next steps, so you can help them at home. In Year 4 the children complete the MTC where they need to demonstrate their knowledge of all the times tables. If you have any questions, please send me a message on Dojo.
