### Literacy

This week in English and our personal, social and emotional development, we have read the book 'Ruby's Worry'. We discussed what worries we have had in the past and how we have overcome them. We considered how we can help our worries go away, or make them smaller, by talking to a trusted adult. We also began to discuss transitions, from nursery to school, and now from reception to year 1. We drew a worry that we have, or have had in the past and discussed how we made it better.

### Maths

In maths this week we have been working on finding one more and one less using a number line. We have also begun working on sharing and finding odd and even numbers by sharing groups between two (halving). Did you know? Halving and sharing in reception is the first stage of beginning to divide!

### Phonics

This week in phonics we have been working on words ending with s and es and longer words with 6 phonemes (sounds).

We also focused on the tricky words says, like, love and some.
