### What have the Mice been up to this week?

#### Literacy

This week our class text has been 'No Dinner' by Jessica Souhami. We really loved this story and were able to join in with some repeated refrains during the second time that we read it. We were also able to predict what happened next. We learnt that the story is based in India, so we had a lesson all about the differences between life in India and our country.

#### Maths

In maths this week we have been focusing on composition to 5. We sang 'five little men in a flying saucer' and each time an alien flew away, we counted how many were left. We worked out all of the different combinations there were to make 5 1.g. 0+5, 1+4 etc. We made our own alien stick puppets so that we can continue with our learning at home.

#### Phonics

In phonics this week, we have learnt the sounds 'oo' as in moon (our rhyme is 'zoom to the moon'), 'oo' as in book (hook a book), 'ar' (march in the dark) and 'or' (born with a horn). We practised sounding and blending words that contained these sounds and segmented to spell words with these sounds in them. Our tricky words this week were 'was', 'you' and 'they'.

### Our Core Concept this term is... Perception and Empathy

#### Other learning this week...

In busy time this week (child-initiated learning), we looked at pictures of rainforests (like the one in our class text, No Dinner). We considered what a rainforest would look like and which animals might live there. We researched in rainforest books and short videos to get some ideas, then thought about how we could turn our book corner into a wonderful rainforest and what we might need. I will post a photo on dojo when it is complete! 😊 We have also enjoyed playing with the lego, playing phonics games, playing on the bikes and trikes and splashing in puddles! In worship this week, Mrs Buss taught us all about how we can be safe and who we can speak to at school or home if we have a worry.
