



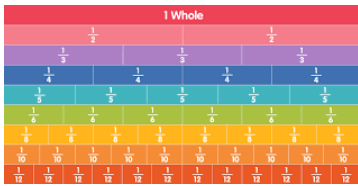
Badgers Class Newsletter.
