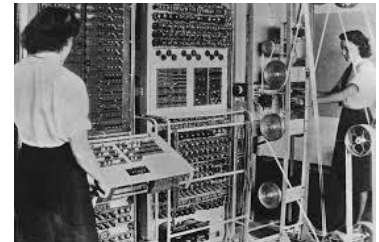


What have the Badgers been up to this week?
