

Use of the (COVID-19) Catch up Funding Grant, Academic year 2020-21.

Spend

This money was used to fund a tutor, who worked with identified pupils, either 1 to 1 or in small groups. As a school, we chose children who particularly needed to catch up in their learning. These pupils were identified as vulnerable children by the school and included some SEND and Pupil Premium children. Detailed assessments were carried out first, to support the identification of pupils most appropriate for this. The focus was particularly on the area of English, both Reading and Writing.

Evaluation

This was evaluated by individually tracking the pupils' progress and attainment using our internal tracking system. This showed that we were able to fill in gaps in the pupils' learning and by July 2021 the majority were at an expected level in English.

Spending of Recovery Premium and School Led Tutoring Grant 2021-22 (total £3,215)

Spend

This will be spent to enable teaching staff in the school to tutor small groups and individual children, whom our internal attainment and progress data shows are not yet on track to be at Expected at the end of the academic year. This will focus on English and Maths. We recognise that tutoring from staff within the school will have the most impact on the pupils.

Evaluation

Our internal tracking data will show how the pupils have progressed and the impact of the tutoring.
